Nonprofit Insurance Advisors: MCN started the taxable subsidiary to serve the insurance needs of nonprofit organizations by identifying and brokering appropriate and cost-effective coverage. Nonprofit Insurance Advisors is wholly owned by MCN. MCN's equity in Nonprofit Insurance Advisors is reflected in other program service revenue. Nonprofit Insurance Advisors incurred a loss in 2014 of \$21,023.

Expenses \$ 375,682. including grants of \$ 800. Revenue \$ -14,721.
